**Product : ALIENPRO****Problem : Alien Pro - Configuring an AlienPro to send email subject to alarm.****Solution :**

The AlienPro can only send email via an SMTP server, this may be an internet based mail server or a local server installed on the same network as the DVR. Most internet based mail servers require a username and password so make sure you have these to hand.

The easiest way to configure the AlienPro's email facility is via the client software as follows ...

1. Click on the 'Configure' tab at the top of the screen
2. Click on the 'Remote Configure' icon on the right hand side
3. Click on & highlight your DVR to the left of the tabs that appear
4. Wait for the client to connect - some fields will be enabled
5. Click on the 'Network Configuration' tab, then 'Email Configuration' button

You now need to enter the fields as described below ...

1. The "sender name" - is the friendly name that the recipient will see in the email, eg : "Alien DVR"
2. The "sender address" - is the email address that, should the recipient click on reply, will reply to
3. Select "Authentication" = Yes
4. The "username" - is the username required to log onto your mail server
5. The "password" - is the password used to log onto your mail server
6. The "verify password" - is the password again to ensure you haven't mistyped it
7. The email receiver "name" - is the friendly name of the person to receive the email, double click to enter this
8. The email receiver "email address" - is the actual email address of the person to receive the email
9. Tick the box 'Attach JPG' if you want JPG attachments sending
10. Select the JPG capture duration (the time between 3 x images)
11. Enter you email server's IP address
12. Click on 'Confirm'
