
### Configure The Camera From Next To The DVR

The CAM802 gives you up the co-ax control of the camera's OSD menu. This allows you to configure the camera whilst sat next to the DVR rather than up a ladder in the cold.

The controller connects in-line between the camera and DVR and requires 2 x AAA batteries.

#### **How To Connect The CAM802**

Disconnect the BNC cable carrying the camera's video feed form the rear of the DVR. Connect the BNC cable to the CAM802 controller and then connect the CAM802 to the DVR. After the camera has been configured the CAM802 can be disconnected and the BNC cable can be re-connected to the DVR.
