A really useful piece of kit for connecting CCTV systems to household television screens. This is an easy way to allow customers to view their cameras on their TV as is commonly requested.

The kit includes a Phono to SCART adapter with audio and video in and out, as well as two BNC to Phono adapters for connecting CCTV equipment to standard TVs.

The audio and video out sockets also enable you to connect most AV equipment to DVRs, quads and switchers.

Using SCART For CCTV In Homes



In this example one of the BNC to Phono adapters would be used to connect the CCTV camera to the SCART adapter. The SCART adapter would then be plugged into the DVD recorder's SCART input. You would then use a phono cable to connect the SCART adapter's video output to the composite input on your TV.

This allows you to connect the DVD player to your TV via a SCART cable as usual. So when the DVD player is displaying an image on the SCART input, you can still flick over to the composite input and view your camera thanks to the SCART adapter's video loopthrough.
